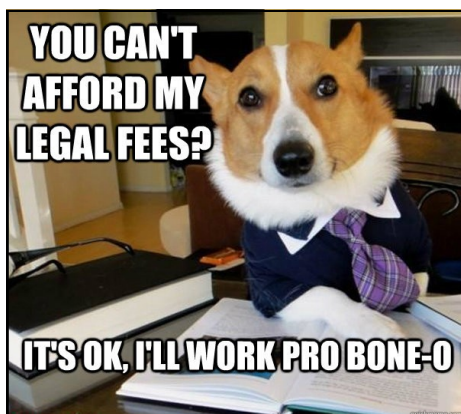

JUSTICE SCALIA'S VISIT

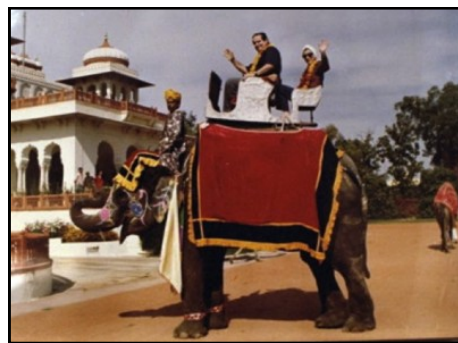
